For most of its history and certainly in recent centuries, the meaning and importance of Ponte Vecchio has been left to the rains, but in 1944 it was subject to a beloved legend between the Venetians, who were preparing to level much of Florence before retreating, and local art lovers—including German diplomats—who wished to save the city's artistic treasures. It was said that the people were walled and killed in the bridge to keep the Allied soldiers, but later learned Ponte Vecchio saved. The national flag came when some...

Deceased Name: Ginger Rogers dies

Dancer's pairing with Fred Astaire delighted Depression-era crowds

LOS ANGELES — Ginger Rogers, whose glittering string of Depression-era musicals with Fred Astaire helped Americans forget the emptiness of their wallets and the grumbling in their stomachs, died Tuesday. She was 83.

Rogers, who won an Oscar for the 1940 drama "Kitty Foyle," died at her home in Rancho Mirage near Palm Springs.

From vaudeville to television, Rogers' career spanned 65 years.

"She was a genuine, 14-karat gold legend," said actress and dancer Ann Miller, who at age 14 starred with Rogers in the 1937 classic "Stage Door."

"She was the one who stuck up for me," Miller said from her home in Sedona, Ariz. "She got me a speaking part. She's a very special lady and she was a very dear friend. I'm heartbroken."

Former President Reagan and his wife, Nancy, were her friends for nearly five decades.

"We are deeply saddened by the death of Ginger Rogers today," the couple said in a written statement. "She was a dear friend for almost 50 years who delighted



Positive Crankcase Ventilation

Operation

The Positive Crankcase Ventilation (PCV) system is designed to allow blow-by and other crankcase vapors to be returned to the engine for burning via the intake manifold. The PCV system accomplishes this by allowing manifold vacuum to draw the fumes from the crankcase. This allows oil vapor to be introduced into the combustion process, also alleviating crankcase pressure and reducing the possibility of oil leaks.

Related Symptoms

Improper PCV system operation can cause oil leaks, oil consumption, poor idle, stalling, increased crankcase pressures, and excessive wear. Increased crankcase pressure due to poor circulation will result in increased levels of blow-by gases and possibly an oil saturated air filter. If the PCV system is leaking, it can cause a vacuum leak or result in a leaner air-fuel mixture at idle. A blocked PCV system can cause a rich air-fuel mixture.
