**Early literacy** is what happens *before* your child learns to read. It is broken down into six skills:

**LOVING BOOKS (Print motivation):** 

being interested in and enjoying books.

#### **USING BOOKS (Print awareness):**

understanding that print has meaning; noticing print everywhere; knowing how to handle a book.

#### **LEARNING WORDS (Vocabulary):**

books contain a wider range of vocabulary than our spoken conversations.

#### **SEEING LETTERS (Letter knowledge):**

knowing that letters look different from each other; knowing letter names and sounds.

**HEARING SOUNDS (Phonological** 

sensitivity): being able to hear the difference between similar sounds and play with the smaller sounds that make up words.

#### **TELLING a STORY (Narrative skills):**

being able to describe things and events, and tell stories.






