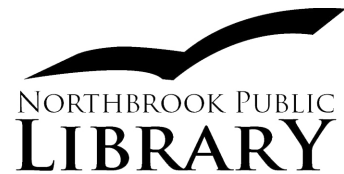

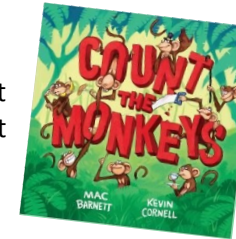

“Hey kids, it’s time to count the monkeys!” Except that something has frightened the monkeys away. How are we going to get them back?

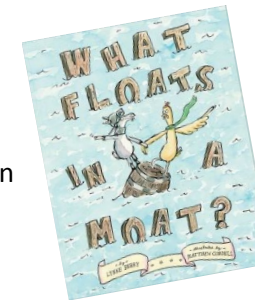


Barton, Chris

An exquisite wordless journey that starts when a child draws a door on her bedroom wall and enters another world where she experiences many adventures, including being captured by an evil emperor.

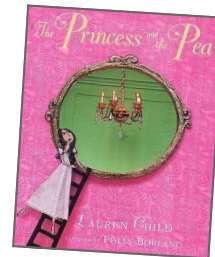
Becker, Bonny

The heartwarming true story of a dog who floated 75 miles trapped on a sheet of ice, and the dramatic attempts to rescue him.

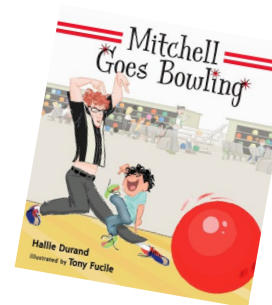
Child, Lauren

**Buffalo Music**

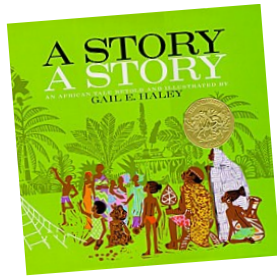

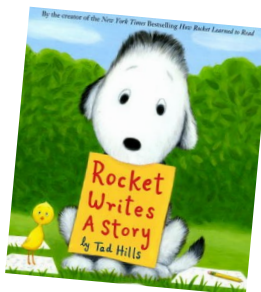
**Fraidy zoo**

**Rocket Writes a Story**

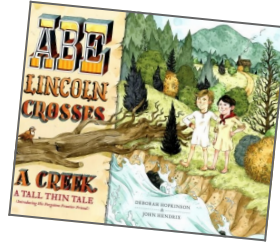
Rocket the dog learns how to write a story from yellow bird.

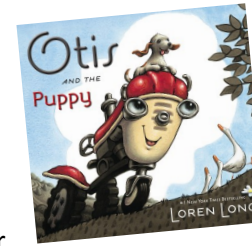
**Punk Farm**

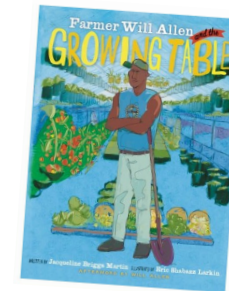
**The Skeleton Pirate**

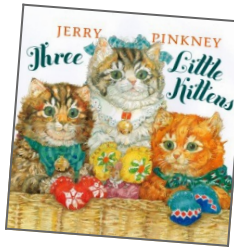
**How to Make an Apple Pie and See the World**

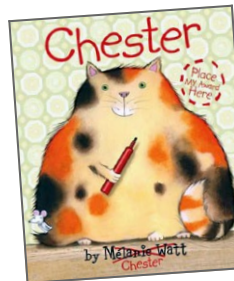
**Dr. Suess's Sleep Book**
